# An opportunity for TEC: NHS Reform

## TEC is Key to the Government Agenda

**Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer has promised:**

*“the biggest re-imagining of our NHS since its birth”*

**Outlining three big shifts for the NHS:**

- 1. Moving care from hospitals to the community*
- 2. Shifting services from analogue to digital*
- 3. Moving away from treating sickness to prevention*

**He also declared that the Government’s 10-year plan for the NHS will ‘have the fingerprints of NHS staff and patients all over it.’**



# New standards for care technology

- In January the Government announced plans for **national standards and trusted guidance** on the best technology in care
- They believe ***‘care technology has a key enabling-role in supporting the Government’s 3 Health Mission strategic shifts’***
- To shape new standards and guidance, they want input from stakeholders, incl. TEC suppliers, innovators, start-ups, and national bodies like TSA
