

Current Guidance on Level 2 PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

Anyone attending to and having personal contact with people - including installers and responders - are now required to wear Level 2 PPE. Stocks of Level 2 PPE are currently being held by local authorities, *please contact your local LA to register as an approved organisation/individual.*

Level 2 is defined as the following:

DIRECT/INDIRECT CONTACT

Disposable Apron

consider fluid-resistant disposable gown if apron provides inadequate cover for the procedure/task being performed

Disposable gloves

(if risk of spraying or splashing)

Eye & face protection

(fluid-resistant Type IIR surgical face mask and goggles or fluid-resistant Type IIR surgical face mask and full face visor)

DROPLET (RESPIRATORY)

Disposable apron

consider fluid-resistant disposable gown if apron provides inadequate cover for the procedure/task being performed

Disposable gloves

Fluid-resistant Type IIR surgical face mask and goggles or fluid-resistant Type IIR surgical face mask and full face visor

AIRBORNE (RESPIRATORY)

Disposable apron

consider fluid-resistant disposable gown if apron provides inadequate cover for the procedure/task being performed

Disposable gloves

Filtering face piece 3 (FFP3) respirator and eye protection or a powered hood respirator.
